

T. V. Fair Asks Students to Enter Education Exhibits

Dates for this year's fair, Aug. 14-18, may seem a long ways off, but school students should enter their education division exhibits now.

Any school work such as arts, crafts, industrial arts, poetry, maps, pictures or reports is eligible for entry in the fair. Cash prizes and ribbon awards are made for first through seventh place. All others receive exhibitor ribbons. Judging will be done at the fair and all entries will be on display there.

Each exhibit should be labeled with the name, address, phone number and age of the exhibitor, and the school attended. Students should check with their teachers for further information.

Last year 473 entries made the Education Division one of the largest at the fair. Education exhibits give the public a chance to view much of the outstanding work being done by students in school.

Personnel from the Tanana Valley Fair office will be visiting area schools later this month to pick up exhibits.
