

Senungetuk And Duncan to Offer Course

FAIRBANKS — Eskimo artist Ronald Senungetuk, assisted by Kate C. Duncan, will offer an intensive five-day course on the University of Alaska, Fairbanks campus in June that will introduce the student to Alaska Native arts and trace their origins and development.

One credit will be given for the course which is scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to noon June 17-21. The course is being offered by the Division of State-wide Services' Extension Center in Arts and Crafts.

Lectures will be augmented by visits to the university museum, instructor demonstrations of artistic skills, and student experimentation in some techniques.
