The application period will be open from January 2 to March 4, 1985, 4:30 p.m. for permits to authorize the use of existing cabins placed without authorization on state lands located in:

- Palmer Hay Flats State Game Refuge
- Goose Bay State Game Refuge
- Susitna Flats State Game Refuge
- Trading Bay State Game Refuge

Filing periods are to be scheduled during 1985 for other areas of the state.

Applications will be accepted only for unauthorized cabins placed on state land before August 1, 1984.

Applications must be received before 4:30 p.m. March 4 at DNR's Southcentral Region Office. Unauthorized cabins for which an application has not been received by the deadline will either be removed or converted to public use cabins by the state.

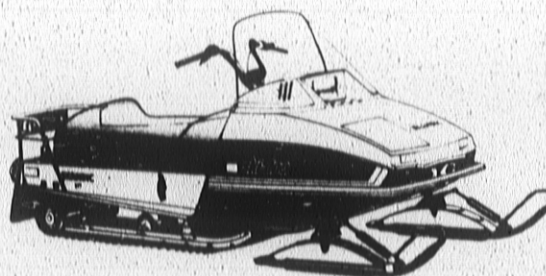
