

PROPOSALS FOR RECREATION

Proposals for preparation of a statewide comprehensive outdoor recreation plan are being requested by the Alaska Division of Lands, Department of Natural Resources.

The plan, which is not expected to exceed \$50,000 in cost, is necessary for Alaska to retain its eligibility under the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund.

The plan is to be completed by July 1, 1969, and must meet all standards

established by the federal Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, said Ted Smith, chief of parks and recreation for the Division of Lands.

Proposals will be accepted by the Division of Lands, 344 Sixth Ave., Anchorage, until 5 p.m. Jan. 31. The proposals will be used as the basis for selecting one or more planners for further discussion and negotiation of a contract.
