

KFAR-TV to Televisify Tundra Times Banquet

Starting at 8:30 p.m. at the Switzerland, KFAR-TV will televise the banquet for one hour.

The television time will be arranged to televise the main speakers and these are expected to be Secretary of the Interior Stewart Udall, Gov. Walter J. Hickel and possibly others.

The schedule for the TV time was arranged to accommodate Gov. Hickel who said he would have to leave the banquet sometime around 9:30 p.m. to make

an appearance at the State Chamber of Commerce convention in Fairbanks that will be going on also that evening.

There has been conflicting speculations as to what Secretary Udall will talk about in his keynote speech. Everyone, however, seems to agree that he will talk about native land claims matters as well as the land freeze.

Beside the TV audience, the speakers are expected to have

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a large audience at the Tundra Times banquet. Max Fugue of the Switzerland is setting up tables to accommodate 650 people.

The banquet committee of the Tundra Times to have a capacity crowd and the 650 seats are expected to be occupied. The committee has also arranged for additional space to seat people for meals at the luncheon salon of the Switzerland on the upper floor should an overflow occur. Fugue said he could seat additional 100 people there.

Max Fugue also said that there will be supplemental food for the banquet and these would be chicken and possibly salmon beside the 463 pounds of Alaska king crab, reindeer stew and caribou stew.
