

Wien Consolidated Says Some Visitors are Getting to Barrow

Some visitors are now getting to Barrow—but not on regular package tours—, Frank Whaley said today.

He explained that uncertainty of landing times and conditions, due to airport construction at this northernmost point, these

visitors go on regular ticketing because the airline cannot guarantee regular schedules.

Efforts are being made to make daily flights, he said. However, the airline is providing sightseeing tours and parkas and footgear and the Barrow Eskimo Dance Club is holding dances when visitors are in town.

There is adequate housing for 25 persons who remain overnight and care to take their chances on getting out.

Just as soon as the airport conditions permit, regular scheduled tours will be started to the most northern point of Alaska.
