Kito to Serve on UA's Board of Regents

Sam Kito, executive vice-president of Doyon, Ltd. has been appointed by Gov. Jay Hammond to serve on the University of Alaska's Board of Regents. Kito will replace Edith Bullock on the board to serve an eight year term.
