20 AAC 15.040. Conditions of Loans. A new section is added, stating that loan applicants who intend to enroll in a flight school program must hold a valid private pilot's certificate as a prerequisite of eligibility.

20 AAC 15.060. State Forgiveness Payments. All sections are amended and re-enacted. Forgiveness payments will no longer be issued as annual refunds.
