Major Duties/Responsibilities:

With direction from an Assistant Health Director provides substance abuse counselor training, substance abuse prevention/education training and broad training in a cross-cultural setting. Training is provided using available manuals to comply with State Office of Alcohol and Drug Abuse requirements. Training is for treatment center and village-based employees of the YKHC. Additional training is provided to counselors from adjacent regions. Administrative responsibilities include meeting State reporting requirements to secure funding; developing and writing grant proposals; budget management; developing the annual training schedule; managing travel logistics—to and from training sessions; and collection and recording of data required for counselor certification.

Curriculum development responsibilities include the implementing of various kinds of needs assessments in the region to decide and develop appropriate training programs in conjunction with the curriculum provided by the State. Supervises the Assistant Trainer, who is responsible to translate all training material into Yupik. Qualifications: Must have a Master's degree in related area; two (2) years experience in substance abuse, primary prevention, counseling, budget management, cross-cultural environments and training/education. Some travel is required to outlying villages in Southwest Alaska.

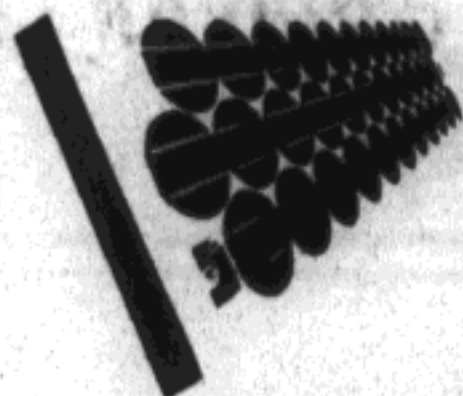

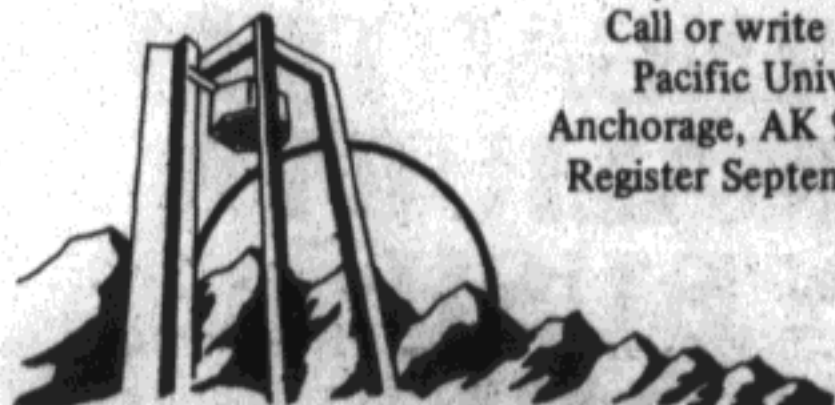
