The Sohio Scholarship Program, which has been conducted in Alaska over the past six years, underwent a major revision this year with the resulting new program being seen as more responsive to student needs.

The new scholarship program was developed in cooperation with the Commissioenr of Education and the Alaska Association of Secondary School Principals (AASSP). The AASSP, through its Board of Directors, is also instrumental in the administration of the program. The Board of AASSP represents all of Alaska's school districts.

In making their scholarship award decisions, principals, the AASSP Board and the Commissioner of Education used the following, non-weighted criteria: academic achievement, leadership potential, community/school involvement and financial need.

When the program is fully implemented four years from now, Sohio will be awarding \$116,000 each year in new and continuing scholarships to 100 Alaskan students.
