

Alaska student loans are still available for next fall

The deadline for applying for Alaska student loans for the 1980-81 school year on a priority basis expired May 15, according to Kerry Romesburg, executive director of the Commission on Postsecondary Education. However, students desiring loans to attend college or any level postsecondary school may continue to submit applications, he added.

"The only real consequence of applying after the priority deadline is that the student may receive the loan award after the school term begins," Romesburg said.

Undergraduate students can apply for up to \$3,000 per school year, and graduate students, up to \$5,000.
