FACT: In 1981, the percapita cost to Alaskans for stat government is expected to reach \$3,535. This is by far the highest in the nation. For example, in 1977 runner-up Hawaii paid only \$1,511 per citizen to support their government-while our per-capita cost was \$2.528.\*\*\*

FACT: Alaskan taxpavers support more State employees percapita than any other state. In fact, of each 10,000 Alaskans, 389 are on the State payroll. Compare this with an average of 136 per 10,000 for the U.S. as a whole. And Illinois manages to get by with just 101.\*

CONCLUSION: Alaska cannot ignore runaway govern-ment. And responsible Alaskans can't

ignore the facts about the ultimate effect that a government out of control will have on all of us.
