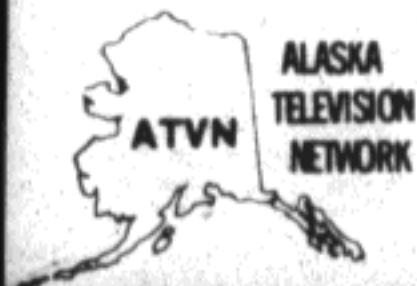

SENIOR EMPLOYMENT PROGRAMS

Seniors 55 years of age and over may be enrolled to perform jobs such as Paralegal Assistants, Home Chore Workers and other help for the frail elderly, Food Service Workers, Drivers, Outreach Workers, Resource Aides, Museum Aides, Counselors, Instructors, Translators, Domestic Violence Assistants, Child Care, and any other non-hazardous jobs.

Training positions which will result in an unsubsidized job and/or upward mobility will be given priority.

Eligible applicants include non-profit organizations, local units or agencies of government, and Alaskan or Indian entities not organized for profit. Some match may be required, administrative costs may be used for match only.
