Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials and performing all work for Project F-095-2(2), Front Street, Grant Street to Mission Street, Ketchikan, described herein, will be received until 11:00 a.m. PST., April 11, 1968, in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project consists of grading, drainage and concrete paving of 0.13 miles of Front Street in Ketchikan and construction of a 296 foot reinforced concrete viaduct.

Principal items of work will consist of the following: Removal of Structures and Obstructions, all required; Concrete Pacement, 1,900 square yards; Class A Concrete, 520 cubic yards; Reinforcing Steel, 95,000 pounds; Welded Wire Fabric, 19,400 pounds; 32 Prestressed Concrete Beams; 560 linear feet of Aluminum Bridge Reiling; and miscellaneous items of work.

All work shall be completed by November 15, 1968.

Plans and specifications may be obtained by all who have a bona fide need for them for bidding purposes from the Cammissioner of Highways. Plans may be examined at Department of Highways District Offices in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau and Valdez.
