

ANF receives funds to continue 14(c) program

The Alaska Native Foundation has received Fiscal Year 1991 funding to continue its 14(c) program, according to ANF.

The purpose of ANF's 14(c) Technical Assistance Program is to provide education, training and "hands-on" technical assistance to Native village corporations with obligations to reconvey land to individuals, organizations, cities or the state pursuant to the provisions of Section 14(c) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act.

ANF has been providing the technical assistance to villages requesting this service for some time. In addition, ANF, in cooperation with the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, has annually sponsored a statewide seminar on the 14(c) process.

The sixth 14(c) seminar will be held Oct. 22-24 at the Anchorage Hilton. Early registration is encouraged as space is limited.
