

# It's time to apply for Coast Guard Academy for '95

The U.S. Coast Guard Academy is now accepting and processing applications from both men and women for appointment as cadet, U.S. Coast Guard, Class of 1995.

Appointments are tendered solely on the basis of an annual nationwide competition with no congressional nominations or geographical quotas.

Applications must be submitted to the director of admissions before Dec. 15. Candidates must arrange to participate in either the College Board Scholastic Aptitude Test or American College Testing Assessment prior to or including the December 1990 ACT and SAT test administrations.

Candidates must be unmarried at the time of appointment, have no legal obligations resulting from prior marriage and must have reached the age of 17 but not 22 by July 1, 1991.

All candidates must be assured of high school graduation by June 30, 1991, and must have completed a minimum of three years of English, three in mathematics to include algebra and plane or coordinate geometry or their equivalents, and must fulfill basic physical requirements.

Cadets receive pay and allowances fully adequate to fulfill their ordinary living expenses.
