

# Scholarships Open

A limited number of travel scholarships are now available for American Indian and Alaska Native media students wishing to attend the Fifth Annual National Indian Media Conference scheduled to be held May 4, 5,

and 6 at the Sheraton - Spokane Hotel in Spokane, Washington.

The three day conference is being sponsored by the Native American Public Broadcasting Consortium (NAPBC) and the American Indian Film Institute. It will include workshops in Radio, Television, Broadcast Production, Print Media, Indian Communications, Public Relations, FCC and Government agencies presented by Indian and Non-Indian media experts.

The travel scholarships are being offered by the NAPBC and the Corporation for Public Broadcasting. They will provide for one half of the travel costs plus two days lodging. They will be awarded first to currently enrolled college students at the Junior/Senior Level and above; second to vocational students and third to on the job trainees in specified media programs.
