must have a valid 1981 vessel
license before engaging in fishing
or transporting raw fish.

Permits and vessel licenses are issued only from the Juneau The Entry Commission urges all fishermen and vessel owners to renew their permits and vessel licenses promptly to avoid loss of valuable fishing time at the beginning of the
