Navy Seaman Rolland Amos, son of Walter T. and Nona M. Amos of P.O. Box 4, Mekoryuk, Alaska, is currently deployed to the Western Pacific and Indian Ocean.

He is a crewmember aboard the fast combat support ship USS Camden, homeported in Bremerton, Washington.

During the cruise, his ship will support units of the U.S. 7th Fleet during training operations. Enroute to its assigned station, the Camden made port visits in Hawaii and the Philippines.

His ship is 793 feet long and carries a crew of 550. It is designed to provide rapid replenishment of petroleum, munitions, provisions and supplies for other fleet ships while at sea, and is capable of supporting an entire carrier battle group for lengthy periods.

A 1974 graduate of Alaska International Academy, Anchorage, Alaska, Amos joined the Navy in July 1978.
