

VA Assists in Flood Damage Repair Job

The Veterans Administration is cooperating with other Federal agencies to assure assistance in repairing flood damage in Fairbanks.

Howard C. Christie, Manager of the Juneau VA Regional Office, announced last week that the Seattle VA Regional Office which handles home loans in Alaska has released letters to persons in the Fairbanks area making payments on VA loans.

The letters request a report of flood damage by return mail addressed to the VA

Regional Office, Sixth and Lenora Bldg. Seattle, Wash. 98121.

Veterans having VA guaranteed loans are requested to report flood damage to their homes to the firms to which they make their mortgage payments.

All reports of damage should contain a complete itemized list of the flood damage to the property and include the VA loan number.

Forbearance on recurring payments in the immediate future will be granted on an individual basis.
