Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project E-R-391(1) and S-851(36), Copper River Highway, Mile 33 to Mile 38.1 described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time; November 9, 1972 in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project will consist of grading 3.8 miles of roadway and construction of 8-bridges. The project is located 33 miles north of Cordova, Alaska.

Principal items of work consist of the following: 41,000 cubic yards of unclassified excavation; 46 acres of clearing and grubbing; 183,000 cubic yards of borrow; 13,000 cubic yards subbase B; 65,000 tons of Class II riprap and 19,000 tons of spall facing; 470 cubic yards of Class I excavation for structures; approximately, 1,410 cubic yards of Class A concrete and 482,000 pounds of reinforcing steel, lump sum, all required; 135 each, precast beam sections; 7,000 linear feet of steel pipe piles, furnished and 106 each steel pipe piles, driven; 7,200 linear feet of metal bridge railing; and miscellaneous items of work.

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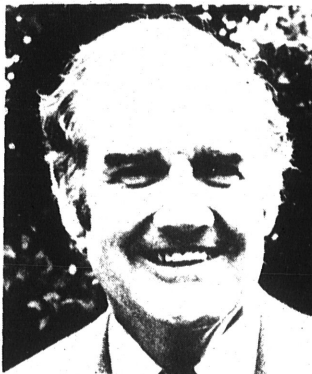
