## olitics can be used to change future

As Alaska Natives think nout the future they should egin to think in terms of who iey want to be and what relaonship they want with other, on-Native peoples, says Seaska Chairman Byron Mallott.

Mallott said that Alaska Naives have to decide in the uture "not only how we got ere but who do we want to be. What is it we want to be ible to say to other people ible to say to other people that is important to us.

"We talk about our culture nd identity. We know we vant to survive as a Native eeople and to continue to be ecognized as a racial identity," aid Mallot, but he said the important question is how to plate to others.

"We can exist in isolation nd in spite of others or we can use our influence nd ideas to make changes and work with the public so they an join us." said Mallott.

Mallott said that part of the vay to achieve change is to work within the political sysem. But that system has a bad eputation among many peple, he says.

"It is ironic that if Native

leaders have a reputation among the community it is for being good politicians," he said. "If people want something done, they go to Native politicians," he said.

"Politics has to do with making change. Managing change is not something that should be taken lightly at all. Many of the institutions that we must change do not share our aspirations or understand our aspirations or the goals of the Alaska Native people."

Good politicians can neip change that, he said but "to make change you have to have some sense of what it is you want to achieve"

Mallott said that when Alaska Natives have set their sights on a goal they can unify and achieve what they want. "That's politics," he said.

But to achieve what they want, people must change the institutions and that takes dedication and vision, he said.

"We talked about what Native people determined for themselves as important and how to achieve it in such a way that people respond. We have demonstrated that we have been able to do it in the past and there is no question but that we will be able to do it in the future."
