Pursuant to Presidential Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities provides notice of proposal to place approximately 28,000 cubic yards of clean granular fill in the base floodplain of Campbell Creek. The control of the Campbell Creek. Minnesota Drive and Arctic Boulevard on Anchorage, Alaska.

This material is required for widening the existing roadway from 24 feet to 86 feet and to comply with Federal Aid Highway Standards. There are no practicable site alternatives to the roadway improvement without turther involvement of the floodplain or extensive right-of-way purchase and relocations.

The bridge over Campbell Creek is to be replaced by a structure designed to span the entire 100-year floodplain of Campbell Creek. Retaining walls will be constructed as a mitigative measure to protect the floodplain from fill encroachment.

The proposed encorschment fells within a designated flood hazard area, but will not cause flood related impacts to homes or businesses because placement of fill should not alter backwater elevations during highwater periods. Natural and beneficial floodplain values will be maintained as the bridge will adequately pass the 100-year flood and fish species indigenous to the Campbell Creek. The proposal will not directly or indirectly support, incompatible floodplain development because the project will only replace and upgrade the existing facilities.
