

# Ahtna announces Dec. 1 deadline for scholarships

The Ahtna Heritage Foundation Scholarship application deadline for students attending college in the spring is Dec. 1.

Applications are available at the Anchorage office, 406 West Fireweed Lane, Suite 104, Anchorage 99503; or the Glennallen office through Shirley Miller.

The scholarship committee will meet in December to approve scholarship requests. Awards for those students who have been approved for a scholarship will be made by Jan. 11, 1991.

Scholarships are provided to shareholders of Ahtna Inc. who want to complete a degree or certificate pro-

gram at an accredited college or vocational school. Students must have a grade point average of 2.0 or above to continue to get scholarships.

A student who has been approved for a scholarship may receive up to \$1,000 each semester. The foundation provides scholarships for the fall and spring semesters only. Students are encouraged to apply for other sources of funding for college.
