Higher Education Scholarship Deadlines

To apply for a scholarship grant from the Association of Village Council Presidents to assist in attaining a college education, eligibility qualifications are:

 Applicant must be ¼ or more Alaskan Native and be enrolled to Calista Corporation.

2. Must be enrolled in a four-year

academic year program.

Show financial need AFTER other sources of funding are considered.

Must be accepted by an accredited institution.

The following is a list of REQUIRED paperwork in addition to the application:

a. Final high school transcript, or

GED certificate.

b. Previous college grades (if you attended before)

c. Financial Aid Form (FAF)

d. Admission/acceptance letter from

the college of your choice.

These papers can be sent to the AVCP Higher Education program as soon as you can get them—they do not have to be sent with the scholarship application unless you already have them. YOUR APPLICATION IS CONSIDERED INCOMPLETE WITHOUT THEM, and will not be considered for funding assistance.

The following application deadlines

are set:

Fall term (starting September): April 15th of each year

Spring term (starting January): October 15th of each year

Summer term (starting June): February 28th of each year

These deadlines should help you in deciding which term to start classes. Please be aware that freshmen and sophomore students are not given assistance during the summer.
