## Eskimo artifacts donated to Anchorage museum

Recently donated to the Anchorage museum of History and Art is a fine collection of 28 Eskimo artifacts given by Elizabeth Cole Butler, who gave the Museum large numbers of valuable Eskimo, Aleut and Athapaskan pieces in 1982 and 1983.

This new donation consists of a variety of finely carved ivory pieces, including an elegant story knife and a decorated wrist guard, several items of skin clothing, a dog sled, and two rare feather pouches. The story knife and other artifacts donated by Ms. Butler will be on permanent exhibit in the Museum's Alaska Gallery which will open later this year.
