

Chugach chooses new pres.

ANCHORAGE—Mr. G.R. “Bob” Andersen, Jr., 39, of Cordova was elected as president of Chugach Natives, Inc., at a meeting of the corporation’s Board of Directors on December 3.

Andersen will fill the slot vacated by the death of Richard Janson, who passed away on November 13, only one week after having been elected as president at the Native regional corporation’s fourth annual stockholders convention.

Andersen was chosen by the Board of Directors as a person who could assist the Board in establishing and redefining the goals and objectives of the corporation.
