

# Diplomas for vets

**JUNEAU**—M.W. McDonaugh, Director of the Veterans Administration Regional Office, Juneau stated today that veterans who have not obtained a high school diploma and who have not used up their VA educational entitlement may obtain a diploma by attending school and draw full VA benefits while attending. The veteran will not be charged any entitlement while attending school to get a high school diploma. Veterans may attend any GED program, state approved high school or community college to obtain a high school diploma or equivalent.

Veterans may take this news item to their closest school counselor who will contact the VA offices to obtain approval of the school's program.
