

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE  
REGULATIONS OF  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES

Notice is hereby given that DOT/PF, under authority vested by AS 44.42.030 and 35.05.020, proposes to adopt regulations in Title 17 of the Alaska Administrative Code to implement AS 35.15.000, as follows:

by providing procedures and conditions for grants for the local control of the planning and construction of public works projects.

Notice is hereby given that DOT/PF, under authority vested by AS 44.42.030 and 35.05.020, proposes to adopt regulations in Title 17 of the Alaska Administrative Code to implement AS 35.10.015, as follows:

17 AAC 50.010 is amended by changing the standards for making buildings accessible to the physically handicapped from the standards approved by the American Standards Association on October 31, 1961 to the Uniform Building Code, 1976 edition, as modified by DOT/PF.
