

Kodiak Aleutian Homes Slated for Lump Sum Sale

WASHINGTON—The Aleutian Homes development in Kodiak will be sold on a lump sum basis by the federal government, Sen. E.L. (Bob) Bartlett announced.

The Department of Housing and Urban Development will invite bids for about 330 dwelling units and 50 vacant lots which make up the development, Bartlett said.

The federal government acquired the Aleutian Homes development in a 1964 foreclosure proceeding. The Alaska State Housing Authority has administered the project for the federal government on a rental basis since 1964.

The houses were constructed in the 1950's under a government loan program. They have a current assessed valuation of more than \$4 million.
