

Savoonga boy's body found

The body of Miller Kingeekuk, 18, of Savoonga, was found July 21 near St. Lawrence Island, according to Alaska State Troopers. Kingeekuk left the island camp of Petngeghyk Sunday morning with two other persons in a small boat.

When they failed to return, a search was launched and then

missing boat was found partially submerged about 500 yards offshore, about seven miles from the camp.

Kingeekuk's body was tied to the boat by a rope, troopers said. Boats from Savoonga and Gambell were searching for the others but heavy fog hampered their search efforts late last week.
