Button blanket workshop set

In response to a request from Alaska Heritage Dancers of the Seattle area, the Institute of Alaska Native Arts is co-sponsoring a button blanket-making workshop in Seattle March 19-23, 1984 at the Heritage High School. The other sponsors of the week-long workshop are Sealaska Heritage Foundation and Seattle Indian Center.

The instructor, Esther Littlefield, is a well-known Tlingit tradition bearer who teaches beadwork, button blanket-making regularly at Southeast Indian Cultural Center and Sheldon Jackson College in Sitka.

Approximately 40 Alaskan Tlingits living in Seattle will be participating in the workshop. The workshop is scheduled with two sessions each day: 2-5 p.m. and 6-10 p.m. A potluck dinner will be held on Friday evening.
