Doyon asbestos mine talk set

Robert Rodriguez, Vice President of Doyon Limited will address the Fairbanks-based Native corporation's huge asbestos deposit near Eagle when he speaks before the Resource Development Council Thursday, March 15 at Aesops/Suite 201, 711 H Street at 7:15 a.m.

Rodriguez will discuss the economics of developing the project as well as other factors influencing development. In addressing mine development, he will report on current world market opportunities, pricing of the commodity overseas and infrastructure development.

Drilling which followed the orignal discovery in 1969 had defined several large, good grade orebodies, and testing and mine design work has been in progress. A 50-mile road connecting the deposit with the Taylor Highway will have to be built to support the development.
