

Great Northern seeks Southwest Alaska service

ANCHORAGE, AK. ...Great Northern Airlines, Inc. announced today that they have filed with the Civil Aeronautics Board to become a party in the Southwest Alaska Service Investigation for service in Southwest Alaska, according to K. Gene Zerkel, President of the Anchorage based intrastate airline.

Great Northern is seeking authority under the Southwest Alaska Service Investigation to serve the points of Kenai, Homer, King Salmon, Dillingham, Kodiak, Cold Bay and Dutch Harbor.

In addition, Zerkel also announced the temporary suspension of Great Northern's pas-

senger service to Nome and Kotzebue due to lack of revenue in the face of increased fuel

costs. He stated, however, that Great Northern would continue with regular freight and cargo

to the Northwest Arctic, including mail service effective December 1.
