



NEW COMMUNITY BUILDING – The Juneau Tlingit and Haida community council is completing a new community building this summer. The new structure will be used primarily for recreation and includes a gymnasium with a junior basketball court, although plans are to add office space to help pay for the facility. According to community council public relations representative Al McKinley, the building will be completed on October 22 at a cost of \$761,000. It is located on Egan Drive near the Bartlett Memorial Hospital. Ike Cropley, of the T & H Juneau community council is the building inspector, making sure the center meets standards.
