The last cargo plane of the season landed at the Arctic Research Lab's floating ice island, about 600 miles northwest of Barrow this week.

Because of slushy runways, another plane probably will not be able to land for three months.

During the period, supplies and mail will be dropped by parachute.

The ice station, T-3 is occupied by 20 scientists and six support personnel. It is a 100 feet thick chunk of ice which scientists believe broke off from a Canadian glacier.
