

Anaktuvuk to Get Dog Food

Anaktuvuk Pass soon will receive 2,500 pounds of dog food, a gift from the Feed the Huskies project, administered by Owen B. Hunt, president of the Antivivisectionists Society of Philadelphia.

Through the project, 55 villages around the state received 26,500 pounds of dog food this year during spring break-up when food was scarce. The shipment to Anaktuvuk was delayed because of uncertainty as to whether the village was going to move.

The dog food, Friskie dry mix, is being shipped in 55 pound sacks, parcel post by Randy Accord, Fairbanks representative of Carnation Company.

Since 1962, 75,000 pounds of dog food have been sent to villages through private donations to the Feed the Huskies project.
