Creek to Alaska Railroad, described

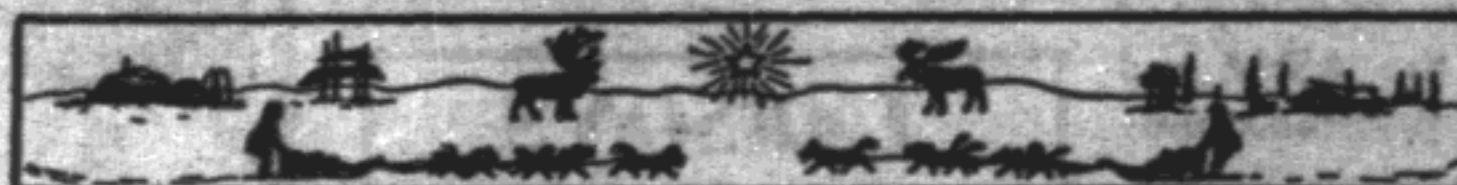
