



**SCHOOL DAYS ARE COMING, SEATTLE**—The first two of 24 schoolroom units Alaska Steamship Company is moving north for the Greater Anchorage Borough School District are being loaded aboard the vanship Nadina. One unit has already been set aboard. They were taken to the port of Whittier and unloaded on August 1. Constructed by Telesar Manufacturing Company, Boise, Idaho for Penney Trailer Sales, the low bidder on the project, each classroom was divided into two separate 14 by 40 foot units which were equipped with wheels for highway transportation to Seattle.
