HOW MANY PEOPLE WILL BE IN THE NEW CAPITAL SITE AT WILLOW WHEN THE CAPITAL MOVE IS COMPLETED?

The consultants to the New Capital Site Planning Commission originally said that there would be 11,400 persons who would live within the site, with many wishing to live outside the area.

However, the Commission, a majority of whom are "anti-move," made the consultant change his figure to 15,000 persons — which helps them drive up the costs that will be on the ballot.
