

# Easley, Epps appointed to lands advisory council

Two Alaskans have been appointed to the National Public Lands Advisory Council by Interior Secretary Donald Hodel.

Paula Easley, executive director of the Resource Development Council, was reappointed for a three-year term. She is chairperson of the Alaska Resource Policy Coalition and

manages the Alaska office of the Pacific Legal Foundation.

Alan C. Epps, professor of natural resources at the University of Alaska-Fairbanks, will serve one year of an unexpired term of a retiring member. Epps, who serves on the Bureau of Land Management's Northern Alaska Advisory Council, is a member and

past secretary of the Alaska Rural Development Council.

The 21-member national group advises the secretary of Interior, through the director of the Bureau of Land Management, concerning national policies and programs for managing the nation's public lands.
