

FAA at Deadhorse

Congressman Howard W. Pollock was informed today by the Federal Aviation Administration that the FAA will operate a Flight Service Station at Dead Horse, Alaska, on the North Slope.

Congressman Pollock was informed that full operation will commence on July 1, and personnel are being moved to Dead Horse immediately.

Pollock further commented that "the departure of the private concern that previously operated at Dead Horse caused a serious safety hazard for flights to the North Slope. The FAA's announcement today will relieve this dangerous situation."
