

Arctic Coast Study Has Been Published

A comprehensive study of the northern rim of Alaska has been published by the Army Corps of Engineers.

Titled: "The Alaskan Arctic Coast; a Background Study of Available Knowledge," the 550 page publication was prepared for the Corps by the Arctic Institute of North America.

It will serve as the basis for an Environmental Impact Statement to be prepared by the Corps on the possible impact of oil and gas exploration and development activities in the navigable waters along Arctic coast.

Limited distribution has been made to university, public, and school libraries in Fairbanks, Anchorage, and Barrow, as well as to concerned Federal agencies.
