

# Authentic Native Articles

The U.S. Department of Commerce and Interior will hold public hearings in Anchorage, Fairbanks and Nome for the purpose of receiving comments concerning Authentic Native Articles of Handicraft and Clothing relative to the Marine Mammal Protection Act of 1972.
