

# Prudhoe jobs available this summer

The American Improvement Matrix (AIM) Youth Employment Program has developed a special summer employment program with oil companies at Prudhoe Bay for college students aged 18-26. This is the third year AIM has offered this program.

Job training ranges from Roustabout level I to general helper positions. Only serious-minded students with a willingness to work and commitment to shift duty that may entail job training for two or more consecutive weeks at Prudhoe Bay before returning home are selected to participate. College students with oil industry related

career objectives are encouraged to apply.

The AIM Office is also offering summer employment to non-college students aged 14-26 at Alaska Native Health Services, Alaska Legal Services and other locations throughout Anchorage, Eagle River and Mat Valley.

Youth aged 14-16 must have parental consent before being employed. On-the-job training is available for document clerks; video and office assistants; day care, recreational, hospital and library aides; and administrative assistants.

The AIM agency is a nonprofit equal opportunity youth employment program operating year-round and offering meaningful employment for youth ages 14-26. Any youth within the stated age limits is accepted into the program; there are no income restrictions. Placements are made with selected employers for both full-time and part-time work. Training periods are determined by the employer and the position being filled.
