

Game board wants proposals

"The Alaska Board of Game will accept hunting and trapping regulatory proposals for the entire State, including areas recently classified as National Monuments by President Carter," Greg Cook, Executive Director of the Board said today.

"State seasons and bag limits apply to all of Alaska, except where further restricted by Federal law. Although sport hunting is banned, some hunting in

the form of subsistence will apparently be allowed within most of the National Park Monuments," Cook added.

Regulatory proposals should be submitted on forms available from all Alaska Department of Fish and Game offices and Fish and Game Advisory Committees. Proposals must be received by the Alaska Board of Game, Subport Building, Juneau, Alaska 99801, before midnight January 19, 1979.
