

Entry deadline for Iditarod Race is February 10

The Iditarod Dogsled Race from Anchorage to Nome which is scheduled to start on February 24 at 10 a.m., has its most critical deadline approaching very soon. Mushers planning to compete in this year's event must have their entry and support fee in the hands of an officer or board member by February 10 at 12 midnight. The

entry fee and support fee totals \$550.

The race is scheduled to start from Anchorage to Eagle River, where the teams will be "trucked" to Wasilla's Lake Lucille for re-start.
