Easements on Native Selected Lands

The Bureau of Land Management is gathering additional easement information pursuant to the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act. Final easement regulations setting forth new criteria were issued November 27, 1978. Among other things, the new criteria provide for the elimination of easements based solely on recreational use and for the identification of "major waterways," i.e., any river, stream, or lake having significant use in its liquid state by watercraft for access to publicly owned lands or between communities.

Existing easement recommendations must be conformed to the new criteria. Recommendations previously submitted

Easements on Native Selected Lands

The Bureau of Land Management is gathering information pursuant to the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act. Easement regulations setting forth new criteria were issued on November 27, 1978. The new criteria provide for:

1. the elimination of easements based solely on recreational use;
2. the identification of "major waterways," that is, any river, stream or lake having significant use in its liquid state by watercraft for access to publicly owned lands or for travel between communities.

Existing easement recommendations must be conformed to the new criteria. Recommendations previously submitted for specific villages will be considered in the conformance procedures. The public is invited to submit, within 30 days, any additional information concerning access-related easements or major waterways to Anchorage District Manager, BLM, 4700 E. 72nd Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska 99507 for the following villages:
