## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation will hold public hearings in four Alaskan cities on proposed Air Quality Control Regulations and the State of Alaska's Air Quality Plan for meeting the standards established by the 1970 Amendments to the Clean Air Act. Comments from the public are invited, and may be in the form of oral or written statements at the hearings, or written statements submitted to the Department of Environmental Conservation. The last day for receiving written statements is March 9.

The public hearings will be held at the following cities: Fairbanks, Alaskaland Theater, 10 a.m., Feb. 25, 1972; Anchorage, Commodore Room—Anchorage Westward, 10 a.m., Feb. 26, 1972; Juneau, Room 117—Federal Building, 2 p.m., Feb. 29, 1972; Ketchikan, Elks Club, 2:30 p.m., March 2, 1972.

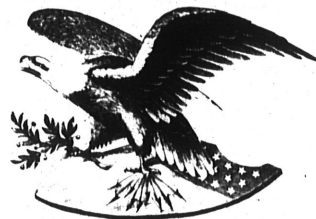
