

Gunderson promoted at Ocean Beauty

SEATTLE — Gilbert Gunderson has been promoted to the position of vice president of Alaska Fisheries Development for Ocean Beauty Seafoods Inc., according to Timothy H. Horgan, chief executive officer.

Gunderson has served as president and general manager of Chatham Strait Seafoods in Petersburg for the past two years. Before that he was a member of the Board of Directors of Sealaska Corp. for 15 years and on the board for Ocean Beauty for six years, serving five years as the chairman.

In his new position, Gunderson will be responsible for fisheries development in Alaska including Southeast Alaska, which will be an early priority. The new position will be a key planning and administrative position. Gunderson will be stationed in Juneau.

Ocean Beauty is the largest subsidiary of Sealaska Corp. and accounted for 72 percent of Sealaska's revenues for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1988.
